History of Magnus Temple No. 3

On the first day of June 1893, thirteen black men from various parts of the country met in the City of Chicago, Illinois, under the leadership of a local attorney named John George Jones. In that meeting, they organized, instituted, and established a fraternal order consisting of well-travelled Prince Hall Masons, to be known as the Ancient Arabic Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine. By the end of December of the same year, thirteen constituent Temples had been organized under the auspices of that Grand Body, one of which being, our very own, Magnus Temple.

Out of concern for the preservation of the Order, the Ancient Arabic Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine was reorganized on December 12, 1900, and was henceforth known as the Imperial Council of the Ancient Egyptian Arabic Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine of North and

South America and its Jurisdictions (A.E.A.O.N.M.S.), at which time Magnus Temple was given its current numerical designation of "3". To further seal its legacy, A.E.A.O.N.M.S. was incorporated on November 13, 1901 in the District of Columbia.

Magnus Temple, organized on September 30, 1893, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, upon reorganization of the Imperial Council in 1900. It was a unique Temple from day one, in that it was the only Temple named in honor of one of its own members, Magnus L. Robinson, a local editor and civil rights activist, and the grandson of former slaves from nearby Mt. Vernon.

For many years from its creation, Magnus Temple flourished; temporarily falling dormant during the economic turbulence of the early 1940's. Not to be defeated, the Temple regained its stature, regaining its charter on November 5, 1946, issued by Imperial Potentate Raymond Jackson.

Throughout its austere history, there have been several members of Magnus Temple who have held instrumental roles, not only in the local community, but in the management and leadership of the Imperial Council, as well. Two of those early members, then Imperial Chief Rabban Robert D. Ruffin and Imperial Recorder Magnus L. Robinson, were active participants in the 1900-1901 reorganization and incorporation of the Imperial Council. Past Potentate (Honorary Past Imperial Potentate) John E. Strange was an Imperial Organizer, whose legacy will live forever, as he is credited with planting the seed for an auxiliary Court to Magnus Temple, and oversaw the organization of Magnus Court No. 100, (then) Daughters of Isis. Honorary Past Imperial Potentate, Dr. Henry M. Ladrey, M.D., served as Imperial Director of the Tuberculosis and Cancer Research Foundation department from 1955-1982.

Also, to its credit, Magnus Temple No. 3 is home to two Past Imperial Potentates. The 26th Imperial Potentate, Noble Roswell L. Taylor, would serve in that capacity from 1982-1984, and also held the distinction of having previously served as Most Worshipful Grand Master of the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Virginia. Most recently, Noble Rochelle J. "Rick" Julian, the 41st Imperial Potentate, would also serve in that capacity from 2014-2016, and continues to be active on the Council to this day.

Truly a legacy of excellence and service, Magnus Temple No. 3 has been, and remains, home to a host of appointed Imperial Directors and Deputies, who have served, and continue to serve, in various capacities for the Imperial Council, along with its work and involvement in the local community.



Heru Peacock aka "Mozart Noir" (The Black Mozart) is a professional violinist, guitarist, and composer that runs his on music business Mozart Noir Music Group LLC based in Southeast, Washington DC.

Heru has played the violin for about 20 years and trained professionally in California as a Yehudi Menuhin Scholar. Heru has performed classical music on numerous international tours in countries such as Italy, Spain, and Canada. Growing up as a Black violinist Heru recognized the importance of representation and began performing Black music on the violin incorporating a fusion of classical music with genre's such as Hip-Hop, R&B, Go Go and Rock. Heru has also performed on the violin and guitar during the "Don't Mute DC" movement. With all of the violence occurring around young people in Southeast DC and the DMV as a whole, Heru believes it is important to show people someone that looks like them doing something positive in a digestible manner, which is one of the many reasons why he enjoys performing hip hop music on his violin. Heru Peacock is a professional trap violinist that blends the sounds of the streets with soulful strings to bring modern Black representation to what has historically been seen as an upper echelon, classical instrument for the elite. That is exactly what he intends to do with his work on the violin. Heru's goal is to represent a convergence of hip hop and Black excellence to demonstrate the limitless possibilities that exist when Black youth are encouraged to explore positive outlets for their creativity.
